## Dear Friends,

In 1954, Simon & Schuster published Dr. Bernard Bain's account of raising "My 100 Children" in the foothills of Virginia at the Presbyterian Home. In the 70 years since this was written much has changed on the campus of what is now HumanKind. Yet our care for children, families, and our community remains steadfast. Our mission to empower people to thrive wraps around each person we serve.

As you probably know, we don't house children on our campus anymore; instead, we serve many more — along with their families and communities. We meet people where they are, understanding their goals and dreams, and building on their strengths.

In 2024, for the first time, we exceeded over 100 children in HumanKind's Treatment Foster Care. This growing program invests in families across the commonwealth to love and care for children, most of whom are dealing with trauma and grief.

We also served more than 100 children through Healthy Families in 2024. Having just become a grandfather for the first time recently, I have renewed appreciation for the work of our team who visits families, partnering with them to provide knowledge, confidence, and resources. There's so much value in having someone sit with you, listen, and provide the guidance you need — it's important to know you are not alone.

While we care for children, that's not our only goal. We're empowering whole families to provide safe homes and to be strong caregivers. Our Early Head Start centers offer so much more than childcare! Families answer, "What's your goal?" not just in their first meeting but throughout their experience with our teams. They build plans on their dreams, determination, and resilience.

In 2024, we saw our Ways to Work and Economic Resource Center expand to more communities, including Roanoke and Warrenton, helping more people secure fair-interest loans to provide personal transportation. If you've ever tried to take a child to a doctor's appointment, get groceries, or find a job on a bus line, you know how lifechanging a



car can be. We've also become an administrator of the Family Crisis Fund for the City of Richmond, distributing needed funding for hundreds of families.

Our communities have come together in significant ways to partner with us to make this growth possible. The 2024 Turkey Trot was the biggest ever, and our diverse donors are critical to our mission. At the end of the day, it is our partnership with caring people and organizations that sustains us.

While this report has many numbers, as a good impact report should, please know that there are real people and powerful stories represented by each figure. We'll keep trying to tell those stories in our newsletters, social media, and through our events. At HumanKind we believe in names over numbers.

We value your partnership and thank you for helping us continue the legacy of 100 children. We are keepers of an important mission: to empower people to thrive. May our spirit of service to this mission propel us for another 70 years!

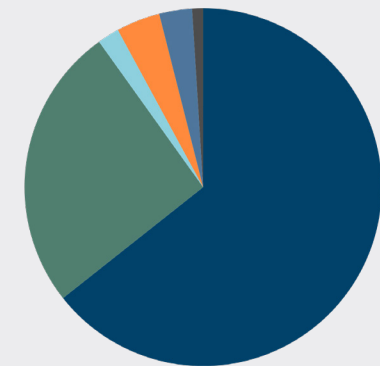

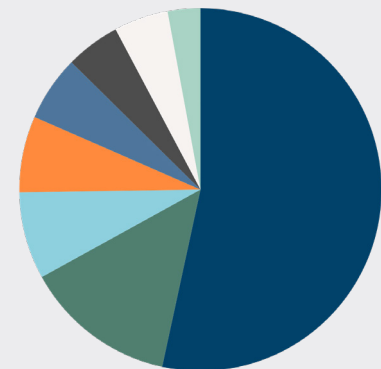

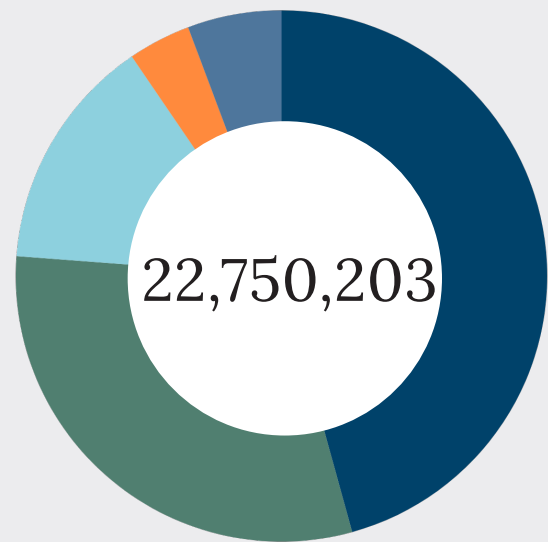

# Financial Overview

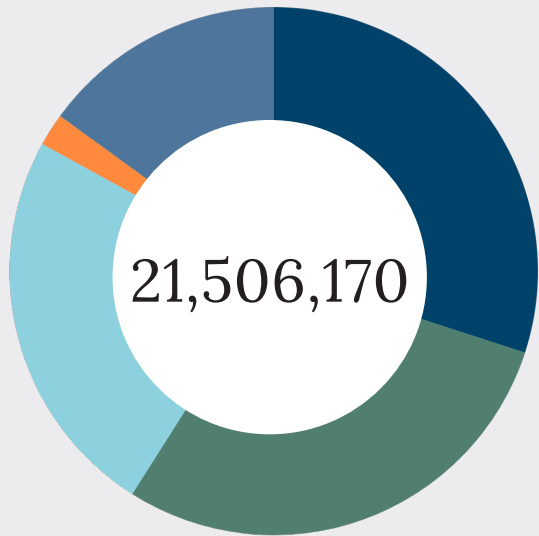

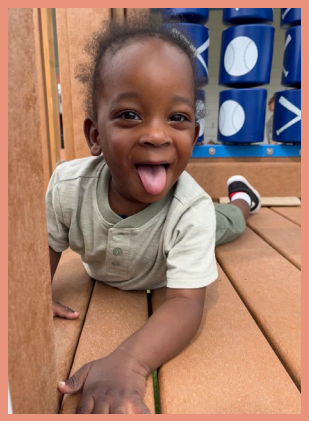

With encouragement and support, she formed close friendships and now actively participates as a cheerleader in the Special Olympics. This program goes beyond housing—it fosters meaningful relationships and empowers individuals to engage in activities that bring joy and a strong sense of belonging.

Humankind's Early Head Start provides support for parents and free, full-time child care for infants and toddlers in Bedford and Lynchburg. This program provides tools and resources to parents of children ages 0-3 at home and in our centers so that they can build a strong foundation for life.

Nicole recently turned to Early Head Start during a time of deep crisis. Overwhelmed and trapped in an unhealthy relationship, she feared for her and her children's safety. Our dedicated specialist partnered with her to build a support network and take the first steps toward a new beginning. With a safe home established, she began therapy to heal from trauma and plan for the future. Despite past discouragement, she pursued her long-held dream of attending cosmetology school. Today, she is a proud graduate, building a career and a stable life for her family.

Before connecting with Ways to Work, life had become a daily struggle for Naomi. Transportation challenges made it difficult to maintain steady employment—but that changed when she received support through the program. With reliable transportation, she could “get to work without missing days” and even explore opportunities for overtime or better jobs. This newfound stability helped her catch up on bills and regain financial footing. But the impact went beyond logistics. She described the HumanKind staff as “the sweetest, most helpful people I have met,” and said their kindness gave her “the strength to keep going” during one of the hardest periods of her life.

Referred through the Blue Ridge Pregnancy Center, Brittany, a mother of three, was determined to create a safe and nurturing environment for her growing family. Facing the challenges of intimate partner violence and a pending custody case, she courageously reached out for help. Through Healthy Families, she connected with vital resources—counseling, a YWCA victim advocate, and a Centra Perinatal Navigator to secure Medicaid. With support in place, she began bonding with her new baby and planning a brighter, violence-free future for her children.

### FOSTER CARE

Our treatment foster care program trains and supports loving foster parents to provide around-the-clock care for at-risk children who have been removed from their homes.

When Lily entered foster care due to neglect, she was far behind developmentally. Her biological parents, heartbroken and struggling with addiction, vowed to reunite with their daughter. Despite a relapse along the way, they committed to recovery and worked tirelessly to change their lives. Meanwhile, Lily's foster mother provided loving care that helped her catch up on both physical and verbal milestones, eventually graduating from therapy. After 551 days, Lily was joyfully reunited with her parents—now sober, stable, and ready to begin a new chapter together as a family.
